**COMMENTS OF UNITED STATES CELLULAR CORPORATION**

United States Cellular Corporation, (USCC”), by counsel and pursuant to the captioned Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (“NPRM”) hereby submits its comments in support of the proposed amendment to the Table of DTV Allocations. The NPRM provides that comments are to be filed within fifteen (15) days of publication in the Federal Register of the NPRM. Publication occurred on December 26, 2013. Thus, these comments are timely filed.

By its petition for rulemaking (“Petition”), Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. (“Family”) explains that the subject change would serve the public interest. Family has further demonstrated that the proposed change is being requested in conjunction with a voluntary industry settlement that will facilitate the offering of quality wireless broadband by a USCC affiliate. Lastly, Family has demonstrated that the proposed change falls squarely within an express exception to the Commission’s “freeze” on channel reallocations and assignments. In short, Family has demonstrated that grant of its Petition would further several important objectives and would not violate any rules or policies.

For all of the foregoing reasons, USCC urges the Commission to grant promptly the Petition and the relief proposed in the NPRM.
