Declaration of Dale Patrick

1. I am the Senior Manager, Outside Plant Engineering, for ACS. I have approximately nine years of experience with ACS in the specifying, purchasing and scoping the materials and contract labor used in network deployment, and before that I performed similar functions for 33 years with CenturyLink, Continental Telephone, and PTI Communications.
2. I have reviewed the 21 labor input changes presented in Confidential Attachment A to these “Comments of Alaska Communications Systems” representing ACS-specific network installation costs, and I am familiar with the contracts between ACS and its outside plant contractors for the Central District. The files presented in Confidential Attachment A accurately represent the current cost to ACS of each of these 21 labor installation tasks.
3. The information provided in this filing is based on the currently effective Central District Outside Plant Contract provided as part of Confidential Attachment A – Outside Plant Labor Contract – Central District. The prices contained with the contract represent the results of a competitive bidding process based on ACS’s standard, competitively bid contract procedures, and represent the lowest bid

received in each ACS operating district. ACS operates 4 districts in Alaska and the Central District, which contains the Anchorage Study Area, generally has the lowest contract labor rates.
