The Wireline Competition Bureau respectfully submits the following into the record of the above-captioned docket, in regards to the challenge process for the second round of Connect America Phase I.

On September 24, 2013, Burnie E. Snoddy, Senior Telecommunications Consultant, Kiesling Associates, contacted via e-mail Ryan Yates, Attorney Advisor, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau, as well as Malena Barzilai and Eric Einhorn, both of Windstream Communications, to state that Winnebago Cooperative Telecom Association's challenge related entirely to its competitive territory, not its incumbent local exchange carrier territory. A copy of that e-mail is provided as an attachment to this document.

On November 11, 2013, Ryan Yates, Attorney Advisor, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau, contacted via phone Gail Odell, Authorized Representative, Muenster Telephone Corporation of Texas d/b/a Nortex Communications (Muenster). In the conversation, Ms. Odell confirmed that Muenster's filing of September 27, 2013 related solely to Muenster's fixed wireless network and not its incumbent local exchange network.

On November 19, 2013, Ryan Yates, Attorney Advisor, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau, contacted via e-mail Richard Pedersen, Chief Executive Officer, Cybernet 1. In the correspondence, Mr. Pedersen confirmed that Cybernet 1 was providing speeds of 3 Mbps/768 kbps in all of the census blocks it challenged. A copy of that e-mail is provided as an attachment to this document.

On November 25, 2013, Ryan Yates, Attorney Advisor, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau, contacted via e-mail Randy Klindt, General Manager, Co-Mo Comm., Inc. In the correspondence, Mr. Klindt confirmed that major plant installation of Co-Mo Comm's broadband deployment had been completed and Co-Mo Comm was in the process of bringing subscribers online.
