COMMENTS OF FAMILY BROADCASTING GROUP, INC.

Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. ("Family Broadcast Group" or "Licensee"), licensee of KSBI-TV, Facility ID No. 38214, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, (the "Station"), by its attorneys, hereby submits these comments with respect to the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (the "Notice") adopted in the above-captioned rulemaking proceeding proposing, at the request of Licensee, to amend Section 73.622(i) of the Commission's Rules, the DTV Table of Allotments (the "DTV Table"), to substitute Channel 23 as the Station's DTV channel in lieu of Channel 51 at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The Notice was adopted by the Media Bureau on December 16, 2013, and was published in the Federal Register on December 26, 2013.


Family Broadcast Group reaffirms its interest in the proposed channel substitution. As explained in the Notice, the proposed change in the DTV Table will permit Family to relocate the operation of Station KSBI-TV from Channel 51 pursuant to a voluntary relocation agreement with U.S. Cellular Corporation; operation on Channel 23 will eliminate potential interference to and from wireless operations in the Lower 700 MHz A Block. Upon the adoption of the channel

substitution as proposed in the Notice, Family Broadcasting Group will file the appropriate application to authorize operations of the Station on Channel 23 in the manner described in the proposal submitted to the Commission in this proceeding and, if granted, will promptly construct and implement operation of the Station with such facilities.
