she is very professional and courteous. Due to the "computer system failure we respectfully ask for a 90 day delay on the Foreign tv station license expansion approval. Please acknowledge receipt and lodging of this statement of objection.

WE California consumers of tv broadcast media, vehemently OBJECT to the expansion of "foreign broadcast " license or rights. In LA we had on our "cable" basic 60% NON-ENGLISH tv stations... only 14 were english native language broadcast. English!

Second, Nafta and other treatys' and agreements have not been considered for reciprocity with the Foreign broadcaster[s] seeking approval. In otherwords the FCC should mandate conformity and licensing agreements in writing with the respective "language " broadcasters if approval is mandated by the FCC ruling and chairmans approval.

For example, Korea must give the mirror image of all existing and recipricol approvals granted by the USA.

Third, we implore the "new approvals" to mandate TV subtitles as not to exclude english speaking viewers from the programing.

Fourth, the objection reserves all rights not stated above, that may include the issue that the "grant of foreign tv broadcast " has already met its level of sufficiency and further expansion of "foreign " channels is as public policy inequitable and in confict with native English of the United States.
