On January 16, 2014, Robert Quinn, Christopher Heimann, and the undersigned of AT&T met with Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Pai, and Nick Degani, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Pai, in connection with the above-captioned matters.

AT&T discussed its efforts to prepare a detailed plan for the service-based experiments discussed at the FCC's December 2013 Open Meeting. Specifically, AT&T discussed how its proposed plan will identify all of the TDM services to be discontinued in a trial location, its intention to map those services to successor services, and will include proposed dates for the grandfathering and ultimate discontinuance of those TDM services. The plan also will provide details regarding the provision of notice to affected customers, and the types of information that would be gathered through the trial process.
