I am part owner of 2 stand alone class 4 and part owner of 1 class 4 with a translator. Based on the difference in operations, I support the one time translator filing window, also support any lifting of restrictions to allow AM stations to move existing translators to co locate.

I feel the nighttime COL coverage requirements should be dropped to 50%, making it easier to locate slightly outside of City to be served.

The FCC should take action regarding the noise all over the band. Many places in our 2 millivolt we are drowned out daytime.

The Commission should consider dropping the ratchet rule, and allow major modifications of existing facilities to be filed more frequently, permitting moves of more than 3 channels.

Preference should be given to proposals to improve local service, possibly even allowing a limited night non directional service for daytimer(s). Here in New England we must "protect" vacant Canadian allotments.

Lastly, the quality of AM receivers needs drastic improvement.
