

It is not appropriate for the FCC to allow unfettered development of the Cell-phone/Internet infrastructure, both on private and public land. Towers, etc. that are developed especially with for-profit interests at stake must meet National and local standards that are in place or should be put in place to safeguard the Commons, which includes the scenic landscape. This is especially important now as the general population continues to spend more of its time and resources within our Nation's scenic landscapes. Permitted, new infrastructure must meet current or improved standards that attempt to minimize visual impact.

Tower development impacts the landscape insidiously slow which precludes mitigation. I urge the FCC to not allow relaxation but on the contrary to enforce more fully its ability to oversee this infrastructure.
