By this letter, we are advising you of the current status of your above-referenced petition for exemption from the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) closed captioning rules. On September 26, 2013, the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau (the Bureau) advised you by letter that, absent further action on your part by October 28, 2013, the petition would be dismissed.

We received confirmation from you on December 13, 2013, that you wished to withdraw your petition for exemption from our closed captioning requirements for your program, "Opal Crews Word of Life". Accordingly, your petition has been withdrawn and dismissed without prejudice as of December 13, 2013.
