I write to ask you to modify your proposed rule to grant automatic approval for increasing the size of existing cell towers. I am a frequent visitor to the Adirondack Park in NY and am strongly opposed to your rule's bypassing of the Adirondack Park Agency's cell tower rules. Visible cell towers spoil the beauty and natural character of the park. We are careful in the Adirondacks to make sure towers blend in and have minimal visible impact in the park's wild areas. There is no reason I can see to void this thoughtful and measured policy. Please change your proposed rule to allow the APA to continue regulating the towers.
