On January 23, 2014, representatives of the LEAD Commission, including LEAD Commission Co-Chairs James Coulter and James P. Steyer, along with Ronnie Cho, Dwight Knell, Joni Lupovitz, David Stone, and Frances Vernon, participated in a telephone conference with Chairman Tom Wheeler and Jon Wilkins, Acting Managing Director and Advisor to the Chairman for Management. During the call, the parties discussed the availability of existing additional funds in the Program and the Chairman's vision for utilizing those funds to focus E-rate support on high-speed broadband within the existing structure of the Program.
