As a resident of the Adirondack Park, I am concerned that generic, nationwide plan for cell tower expansions will not work in places like the Adirondack Park that have valuable scenic and historic resources. I request that you not wipe out the APA's successful policy for the siting and modification to cell towers, which has protected the scenic beauty and ecology of the Adirondacks for 12 years, and therefore I suggest that he proposed rule should exempt those areas that have established standards for cell towers, such as the Adirondack Park.
