Re: Revision of Part 15 of the Commission's Rules to Permit Unlicensed National Information Infrastructure (U-NII) Devices in the 5 GHz Band, ET Docket No. 13-49, Notice of Ex Parte

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 30, 2014, Kathryn A. Zachem and I met with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly and Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor to Commissioner O'Rielly, regarding the need to amend the Commission's rules to promote more unlicensed use in portions of the 5 GHz band. Prompt Commission action is critical to sustain the significant consumer and economic benefits that Wi-Fi already provides and to enable the even greater benefits that will result from the deployment of more robust Wi-Fi networks and so-called "gigabit Wi-Fi."¹ We explained that, although certain aspects of this proceeding may require additional time for further consideration, the record is already complete and ripe for a Commission decision with respect to the U-NII-1 band.
