On Monday, February 3, 2014, Dean Brenner and the undersigned from QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”) discussed the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (“NPRM”) in the above-referenced proceeding with the following staff members from the FCC’s International Bureau: James Ball, Howard Griboff, Andrea Kelly, Sean O’More, and Byung K. Yi; the following staff members from the Wireless Bureau: Linda Chang, Melissa Conway, Thomas Derenge, Audra Hale-Maddox, and Brian Regan; and the following staff members from the Office of Engineering and Technology: Brian Butler and Jamison Prime.

Qualcomm discussed the comments and reply comments it filed in response to the proposals in the NPRM. Qualcomm also discussed issues relating to the protection of future NGSO satellite systems that could be deployed in the 14.0 to 14.5 GHz band. Finally, Qualcomm encouraged the Commission to issue a Report and Order authorizing Air-Ground service on a secondary licensed basis in the 14.0-14.5 GHz band as soon as possible.
