Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 15, 2014, Mr. Aaron Panner, on behalf of Neustar, filed an ex parte letter in the above-referenced proceedings, which was redacted in its entirety. On January 29, 2014, Mr. Panner filed a revised, partially redacted version of the January 15 Letter (“Redacted January 15 Letter”). The Redacted January 15 Letter for the first time publicly disclosed that Neustar unilaterally submitted an unsolicited revised bid proposal to the FoNPAC in October 2013, a short time after the September 18, 2013 deadline for submitting a best and final offer.

Moreover, upon review of the Redacted January 15 Letter, which also purportedly reflects the content of Neustar CEO Lisa Hook’s presentation to Chairman Wheeler during a telephone conversation on January 21, 2014,<sup>1</sup> it appears that Neustar likely discussed the terms of its unsolicited revised bid. To the extent Neustar did so, it would have further prejudiced Telcordia and other bidders. In order to permit counsel for Telcordia adequately to represent it and to evaluate the extent of prejudice from Neustar’s unilateral actions, Telcordia’s counsel must have access to the unredacted version of Neustar’s January 15, 2014 letter.


