On January 31, 2014, Frontier filed a Request for Limited Waiver of Section 54.416¹ of the Commission's rules. Specifically, Frontier requested a one week waiver to complete Boxes J, K and L of FCC Form 555 for its two study areas within the State of Utah: Navajo-UT-Frontier, SAC No. 504449, and Citizens-Frontier-UT, SAC No. 504429 ("Utah Study Areas"). To date the Commission has not acted on Frontier's waiver, yet by this letter Frontier informs the Commission that it hereby files the relevant data for Boxes J, K and L for the above-mentioned study areas. Frontier notes that this was done within one week, as its initial waiver requested.
