On February 11, 2014, Victor Tawil, Bruce Franca and Patrick McFadden of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB") met with Robert Weller, Matthew Hussey, and Mark J. Columbo of the Office of Engineering and Technology; Brett Tarnutzer, Jonathan McCormick, and Sasha Javid of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Bill Scher of the Office of General Counsel; and contractors Rudy Sultana, Karla Hoffman, and Melissa Dunford at the Federal Communications Commission.

During the meeting, NAB asked questions concerning the methodology the Commission will use for determining the feasibility of repacking non-participating broadcasters during the voluntary incentive auction. NAB sought clarification on how the Commission will check feasibility during the auction and how the Commission will be optimizing solutions during the auction. NAB also discussed the effects of variation in the amount of spectrum that can be recovered on feasibility determinations and repacking.
