**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL AND
REQUEST TO TERMINATE PROCEEDING**

Michael D. Judy, on behalf of himself and other shareholders of Preferred Communications Systems, Inc. (“Appellant”), hereby withdraws his appeal filed on October 1, 2009 and requests that the Commission terminate the above-captioned proceeding.

Specifically, Appellant has determined it is no longer in Appellant’s interest to pursue the appeals he filed on August 13, 2009, and October 1, 2009, in the above-captioned manner and wishes to withdraw the appeal and dismiss all related pleadings.
