**NOTICE OF ORAL EX PARTE PRESENTATION**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, February 19, 2014, I conducted a telephone conference call with Hillary Burchuk of the Office of the General Counsel and Susan Singer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the telephone conference call, we discussed AT&T's proposed acquisition of Leap Wireless, the significant public interest benefits that the transaction will generate without causing any harm to competition, and that the Commission should approve the transaction expeditiously. In particular, we discussed AT&T's plans for migrating Leap customers following close of the transaction, including potential incentive offers to provide further encouragement to Leap customers to migrate to the New Cricket; AT&T's spectrum holdings in various CMAs; AT&T's LTE deployment; and AT&T's plans to deploy Leap's AWS and PCS spectrum to enhance its LTE network.
