On February 19, 2014, Chris Frentrup of Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”) and Jennifer Bagg, Will Sullivan, and I, all of Wiltshire & Grannis and representing Sprint, spoke via telephone with Betsy McIntyre, Christopher Koves, and Billy Layton of the Pricing Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau; Ken Lynch of the Industry Analysis and Technology Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau; Eric Ralph, Chief Economist of the Wireline Competition Bureau; and Jack Erb of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis regarding the above-captioned proceeding.

Sprint explained that it is working diligently to prepare its data in expectation of the special access data request and asked for guidance regarding several aspects of the data collection. Specifically, the meeting participants discussed the appropriate format in which to submit requested data on purchase price, market trials, IRUs, and wireless backhauls. Sprint also sought clarifying details on how it will be expected to populate date, CLLI, and zip4 information fields.
