DIRECTV gives you a remote which has no CC button. (They say there is no standard for CC control buttons, so they don't offer it.) If you want to control CC you have to have two remotes or buy a special remote.

LG TV: Function to turn CC on or off is deeply imbedded in menus. Their LG Magic Wand remote which is a great remote, has no CC button. So when CC jump in the way of a picture, you have to miss a whole part just to temporarily turn the CC off because the menu covers the whole screen.

Some TV programs that have their logo in bottom right corner cause the CC to be displayed above the logo. This pushes the CC to the middle of the screen which covers the talking persons face which ruins the whole experience. This is really bad when you are watching a program together with people who do not need CC, it ruins it for them.

Would love to see an option that causes the CC to be displayed below the picture on a black bar similar to a letter box area, but only one bar just on the bottom of screen. Could even be just one row of text scrolling from left to right. Or if they had the CC in a floating box that you could reposition anywhere on the screen would be great. Should be able to invert the text/background colors from white text black background to black text white background or should do it automatically. Some CC you can't see because it blends in with the background.

On a lot of shows (live, news, etc.) they just leave out whole sentences all the time. The CC can't keep up with the conversions, so they just give up and jump ahead. This makes a lot of CC worthless. You lose all meaning of what is going on in the conversion.

Anything that you can do to improve CC would be greatly appreciated.
