NOTICE OF ORAL EX PARTE PRESENTATION

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, February 21, 2014, I conducted a telephone conference call with Hillary Burchuk of the Office of the General Counsel and Susan Singer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the telephone conference call, we discussed AT&T's proposed acquisition of Leap Wireless, the significant public interest benefits that the transaction will achieve without causing any harm to competition, and that the Commission should approve the transaction expeditiously. In particular, we discussed AT&T's plans for migrating Leap customers following close of the transaction, including rate plans that AT&T plans to offer upon launch of the New Cricket; potential incentive offers to provide further encouragement to Leap customers to migrate to the New Cricket; and alternative providers of prepaid Lifeline service should Leap Lifeline subscribers wish to choose another carrier. We also discussed AT&T's spectrum holdings in various CMAs; AT&T's LTE deployment; AT&T's plans to deploy Leap's AWS and PCS spectrum to enhance AT&T's LTE network; and the roaming services that will be offered post-transaction. We further discussed that this transaction would not result in harm to competition in South Texas.
