Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 21, 2014, Ross Lieberman, Vice President of Government Affairs, American Cable Association (“ACA”) and the undersigned, counsel to ACA, met via teleconference with Jonathan Levy, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy and Raelynn Remy, Policy Division, Media Bureau to discuss evidence submitted into the record in the above referenced dockets concerning coordinated retransmission consent negotiations. During the call, ACA described its understanding of the methodology employed in its members’ previous calculations, as well these companies’ subsequent clarifications and updates, regarding the prices they paid for carriage fees.<sup>1</sup> ACA discussed how these figures consistently illustrate that multichannel video programming distributors pay higher carriage fees when separately owned, same-market broadcast stations affiliated with the “Big 4” television networks coordinate their negotiations compared to the prices they pay for carriage when broadcast stations affiliated with the “Big 4” television networks negotiate on their own.
