Missouri RSA 5 Partnership d/b/a Chariton Valley Wireless Services is interested in this program.



- c. Broadband technologies proposed – Fixed based wireless LTE – Long Term Evolution.
- d. Expected participation from government/tribal entities – Unknown at this time.
- e. Potential Service offerings – Voice using VoLTE technology and broadband with speeds varying between 5-12 Mbps down and 2-5 Mbps up. VoLTE pricing is yet to be determined. The monthly charges for wireless broadband offering include -
 - a. 10 GB \$50
 - b. 20 GB \$70
 - c. 30 GB \$90
 - d. 40 GB \$110
 - e. 50 GB \$130
 - f. 100 GB \$200
- f. Funding Estimate – Ongoing support is preferred as the service areas listed above are very rural. It is difficult to determine the costs of the project without census block information due to the low number of unserved households and where they are located in the census tract. This information is imperative to determine proper cell site placement to provide service to the unserved entities.
