On February 26, 2014, Kathleen Abernathy, Executive Vice President, External Affairs, of Frontier Communications ("Frontier") and the undersigned of Frontier, with Bryan Tramont, outside counsel for Frontier, met separately with Rebekah Goodheart, Legal Advisor, Wireline, to Commissioner Clyburn, and Priscilla Delgado Argeris, Legal Advisor for Wireline, to Commissioner Rosenworcel. The subject of the meetings was Frontier's proposed acquisition of The Southern New England Telephone Company from AT&T.

Meeting attendees from the Commission were provided with copies of the attached presentation regarding the transaction. The Frontier representatives discussed the topics detailed in the attached presentation, particularly the numerous public interest benefits and the increase in competition associated with the proposed transaction.

Frontier also noted its support for finalizing CAF Phase 2 in a timely manner. Frontier explained how it, and other ILECs, are well positioned to use CAF Phase 2 funding to quickly meet the Commission's broadband goals in rural America.
