Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 26, 2014, William Roughton, Richard Mountford and I of AT&T Services, Inc. met with Tim May of the Public Safety Bureau, Ira Keltz of the Office of Engineering and Technology, Lloyd Coward, Denise Walter and Melissa Conway of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

We explained that AT&T's has developed a process designed to standardize review of managed access deployments on AT&T spectrum and is working with vendors to help ensure deployments both meet the needs of corrections officials and do not interfere with service to legitimate customers. We emphasized that AT&T has devoted significant resources to enable deployments that attack the pernicious problem of cell phone use in prisons and wants to be part of the solution. We also noted that the lease process was not designed to address these types of systems and that AT&T is working on a more streamlined approach.
