Dear Secretary Dortch:

On February 27, 2014, BT met with Chairman Wheeler, his staff Diane Cornell, Daniel Alvarez, and Sagar Doshi, Chief of the International Bureau Mindel de la Torre, and Associate Wireline Bureau Chief Deena Shetler. Representing BT were Sir Michael Rake, Chairman, BT plc, Bas Burger, President BT US and Canada, Sheba Chacko, Senior Counsel and Head, North American Regulation and Global Telecoms Policy, and Jennifer Taylor Hodges, VP, US Government Affairs.

During this meeting, BT explained that it was important to competitiveness in the global network services market that the special access rulemaking be completed as soon as possible. Unaddressed dominance of incumbents in the wholesale access market is causing trade barriers in the global managed network services market. BT also highlighted that regulation of BT's market power where it exists in the UK has not dis-incentivized network investment by BT in the UK.
