Amendment of the Commission's Rules with Regard to Commercial Operations in the 1695-1710 MHz, 1755-1780 MHz, and 2155-2180 MHz Bands

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 28, 2014, Douglas C. Smith, CEO; Janice Obuchowski, and Jay Chauhan, representing Oceus Networks Inc. ("Oceus Networks") met with Erin McGrath, Legal Adviser to Commissioner O'Rielly.

During the meeting, representatives from Oceus Networks provided an overview of company's work adapting commercial wireless technologies for military, first responder, critical infrastructure industry and other markets. Representatives from Oceus Networks identified interest by these users in 4G LTE due to economic and capability benefits.

Oceus Networks identified how a bi-directional sharing framework that provides access by military users to the band pairing, 1755-1780 MHz and 2155-2180 MHz, could fulfill training requirements on remote bases and ranges with limited impact to auction revenues.
