On Thursday, February 27, 2014, Wayne Watts, AT&T's General Counsel, and I conducted a telephone conference call with Hillary Burchuk of the Office of the General Counsel and Susan Singer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the telephone conference call, we discussed AT&T's proposed acquisition of Leap Wireless and the significant public interest benefits that the transaction will achieve without causing any harm to competition. In particular, we discussed rate plans that AT&T intends to offer upon launch of the New Cricket; AT&T's spectrum holdings in various CMAs; AT&T's LTE deployment; and AT&T's plans to deploy Leap's AWS and PCS spectrum to enhance AT&T's LTE network. In addition, we urged the Commission to approve the transaction expeditiously.
