This is to advise that on March 4, 2014 the undersigned together with the representatives of Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC") listed below, met with Julius Knapp and members of his staff and Scot Stone, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and, subsequently, with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel to the Chairman, regarding the above-referenced proceedings.


The AFTRCC representatives urged that action be taken in the long-pending WRC-07 implementation proceeding. In addition, they expressed AFTRCC's willingness and experience in support of the Commission's proposal that AFTRCC coordinate use of the 5091-5150 MHz band for civil flight test operators; supported addition of the new Boeing plant at North Charleston, South Carolina to the list of 52 proposed flight test areas; and urged a reciprocal coordination requirement between aerospace interests and the Federal Aviation Administration's AeroMACS system at the locations referenced in AFTRCC's Reply Comments of March 27, 2013.

In addition, during the first meeting AFTRCC referenced challenges associated with coordinating commercial space flight operations given the very large interference footprint that launch vehicle telemetry creates.
