Re: Next Generation Network Experiments in Rural America - Report and Order in WC Docket No. 10-90

On behalf of Park County Government of Colorado and in potential partnership with Colorado Parks and Wildlife, Park County School District Aurora Water Board and Denver Water Board and pursuant to the above referenced Docket No. 10-90, we Park County, submit the following Expression of Interest.

The proposed service area is located in Park County, Census tract 5, blocks 32 and 26. We have a good faith belief that the following potential customers lack adequate broadband speeds as defined in the Report and Order referenced above.

- The Residents of Lake George, Colorado (unincorporated). Population 2200
- The Seasonal Visitors to the Lake George, 11 mile State Park and Spinney Mountain State Park. - 100K+ vehicles / Summer Season
- The Lake George Charter School – 150 students

As part of this experimental model, the carrier that we are working with in partnership intends to connect Fiber to a Tower and mount a Fixed Wireless systems linking several towers (3-4) to meet the needs of the service area in conformity with the FCC's stated goals contained in its Order.

The services to be offered include but will not be limited to the following: Broadband Internet service at a minimum of 4Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload as well as VOIP Telephone Service (including voicemail, call forwarding, etc).

The governmental entities participating in this proposed deployment include Park County, CO and may include Colorado State Parks, Park County School District, Aurora Water Board and Denver Water Board.

The project we have identified will require \$900,000 for a one time build out of fiber, towers, land leases, power and equipment. Carriers involved in the project may include: Valcom, South Park Telephone company, Centurylink, Commnet and/or others. We look forward to learning more about the program.
