NOTICE OF ORAL EX PARTE PRESENTATION

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, March 7, 2014, I conducted a telephone conference call with Brendan Carr, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Pai. During the telephone conference call, we discussed AT&T's proposed acquisition of Leap Wireless and the significant public interest benefits that the transaction will generate without causing any harm to competition. We also discussed AT&T's voluntary commitments, described in a separate letter AT&T filed in this docket on March 6, 2014, which will further enhance the abundant public interest benefits that the transaction will achieve.

In addition, we discussed the sale of Leap's indirect, minority ownership interest in Flat Wireless, LLC. In particular, we discussed that Leap has a non-controlling, non-attributable minority indirect interest in Flat; Cricket Communications, Inc. has negotiated a definitive agreement to sell its interest in Flat and is prepared to move forward with the sale, but Flat has filed a lawsuit seeking to block the sale of Cricket's interest in Flat. We advised that, should Cricket not sell its interest in Flat prior to close, AT&T is committed to use reasonable best efforts to cause Cricket to sell its interest in Flat as soon as practicable.
