Dear Ms Dortch:

As described in AT&T Inc.'s ("AT&T") letter dated March 6, 2014, for eighteen months following the merger's closing, AT&T will make available a prepaid rate plan for feature phones that includes unlimited talk, text, and data, in accordance with published speed policies, at a rate that will not exceed \$40 per month (including all taxes and fees).¹ At the request of the Commission staff, AT&T hereby provides additional detail about the features of this plan. AT&T currently plans that this \$40 per month all-inclusive rate plan will offer unlimited local and long distance talk, unlimited text/picture/video messaging, unlimited data with a 500 MB high-speed data allowance with lower speeds for additional usage, voicemail, call waiting, and call forwarding.²
