**COMMENTS ON ADDITIONAL REQUESTS FOR LIMITED WAIVER OF ITS INMATE  
CALLING SERVICE RATE CAPS**

NOW COMES **Network Communications International Corp.** (hereinafter "NCIC") who files these Comments in response to the FCC request for comments for Limited Waiver of Its Inmate Calling Service Rate Caps - Rates for Interstate Inmate Calling Services. The FCC seeks comments on two petitions filed by Securus Technologies, Inc. concerning its inmate calling service rate caps.

NCIC hereby supports Securus' request that the nine-month waiver and \$.46 rate cap that was granted to Pay Tel be granted to all providers of Inmate Calling Services serving county facilities located in the same states as Pay Tel. NCIC concurs with Securus' position that all ICS providers operating in those states are subject to the same expenses as Pay Tel.

NCIC hereby also supports Securus' request to allow a \$.02 per minute Voice Biometrics Fee to be added to the interstate rates in order to recoup the cost of providing such technology required for secure inmate calling.
