On March 14, 2014, Michael Kearns, consultant to AT&T Services, Inc., of the University of Pennsylvania, spoke with Kevin Leyton-Brown of Auctionomics, Inc. on the above-referenced proceeding. During the conversation, Dr. Kearns described in general terms the two-fold methodology he was using with PicoSAT to examine both the absolute constraints on repacking solutions at various clearing levels, including determining the minimum number of clearings required nationally and by DMA to achieve various amounts of recovered spectrum, and the constraints on repacking solutions under a variety of assumed models for broadcaster participation. The conversation included a discussion of methodology only; no specific results were shared.
