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I would like to propose participating companies have their replacement technologies be held to a comparably high standard of quality and reliability during the FCC's IP transition trials.

I ask this because as a member of a financially disadvantaged community, there are two things my phone service provides that are of particular importance to me: reliable 911 and a line that works with a burglar alarm. I recently started bundling phone service with Comcast, and have experienced periodic outages, rendering 911 service unavailable. Additionally, I was told by the installer that my alarm would not work with their phone service. When asked why, I was cited differences in the technology they use.

I am now in the process of requesting new service with AT&T. However, this is currently my only other option. I would like to believe that myself and my neighbors will be able to retain this option in the future, as it plays a role in being able to feel safe.
