Subject: Emergency E-9-1-1 tax on mobile and landline phones
Reference: Public Laws of 2005, Chapter 48

I have been trying and trying to understand how much money is being collected by our State to upgrade our emergency 911 system. My family alone, with five cellphones and two landlines is contributing \$6.30 per month – over \$43 a year towards this goal. I can only imagine how much money is being collected from everyone's phones.

I twice have turned to the Office of Emergency Telecommunications Services in the Office of Information Technology and never received a reply. I have submitted an OPRA request to the Office of the Governor. They have directed me to the Office of the State Treasurer.

Therefore I ask two questions:

- First, where would I find a report detailing how much revenue our State received in the most recent fiscal year in accordance with the "9-1-1 System and Emergency Response Fee"?
- Second, where would I find a list of the grants distributed with the monies collected pursuant to this Act (PL 2004, C. 48)?
