Dear Ms. Dortch:

During a March 26 meeting with staff regarding the above referenced proceeding, AT&T was asked about reports that it may decide to deploy eMBMS over its lower 700 MHz D and E block spectrum. AT&T plans are to deploy commercial mobile broadband services over the D & E spectrum using the unpaired D and E block spectrum on 3GPP Band 29 as supplemental downlink, together with AWS or PCS spectrum through carrier aggregation. AT&T is exploring the possibility of offering eMBMS services as well. If AT&T were to deploy eMBMS services in the D and E Blocks, this would also be as supplemental downlink, together with PCS or AWS spectrum using Band 29 carrier aggregation.
