On April 9, 2014, Cogent Communications Group, Inc.'s ("Cogent") Founder and Chief Executive Officer, Dave Schaeffer, met with Henning Schulzrinne, the Commission's Chief Technology Officer.

During the meeting, Mr. Schaeffer explained how Cogent acquired the assets for and built its network, and described some of the architectural, operational and technical aspects of that network. Messrs. Scaheffer and Schulzrinne also discussed certain attributes of the existing U.S. telecommunications infrastructure, as well as the economics associated with owning and operating such infrastructure. In addition, they discussed the process by which additional wireless frequencies may become available in the future.
