Re: Stop the Comcast/Time Warner Cable Merger

Commissioner Rosenworcel:

I am writing to urge you to stop Comcast's plan to acquire Time Warner Cable. If the two cable giants combine, they would create a massive media conglomerate that would dominate our TV and Internet-access markets. Not only bad for consumers, the merger would be bad for our free press and our democracy, allowing one company to have outsized influence over the scope and character of news and public-service programming in dozens of states and hundreds of major cities.

As a Commissioner of the Federal Communications Commission, you are tasked with ensuring telecommunications industry mergers are in the public interest. I urge you to take the necessary steps to block the Comcast/Time Warner Cable merger.
