My name is Shad Groverland and I am the Sound Supervisor for the MGM Resorts International properties which include 11 properties in Las Vegas, with many more around the United States. We have an extensive dependence on wireless microphones in the 600MHz range between our millions of feet of conference center space and partnered Cirque Du Soleil shows at each property.

After we lost the 700MHz range it was a very large financial impact to the corporation as well as lost time replacing inventory with new mics in the 600MHz range. To be forced to do this all again in such a short period of time and after such extensive losses and re-investments, only to be lost again... well it is simply not fair or financially responsible.

As the representative of the sound departments for MGM Resorts International we agree with Sennheiser's proposal for auction winners to compensate wireless mic owners for any equipment that they will not be able to use after spectrum repacking.
