On April 15, 2014, I met with Jonathan Sallet, Stephanie Weiver, David Gossett, and James Carr, all from the Office of General Counsel. We discussed *Verizon v. FCC*, 740 F.3d 623 (D.C. Cir. 2014) and the February 19, 2014 “Statement by FCC Chairman Tom Wheeler on the FCC’s Open Internet Rules.” While I advise several companies and nonprofits deeply supportive of network neutrality, my views expressed were purely personal, based on years of advocacy and academic work on the issue.

We discussed the First Amendment implications that I set out in my article “First Amendment Architecture” (which I have uploaded to this docket). I also reiterated my hope that the Commission will remain open to the option of Title II jurisdiction in its consideration of these important issues.
