I am opposed to this proceeding. Authorizing wide-band stations where narrow band signals and experimentation predominates is very unwise. There has been much successful experimentation within the existing regulations. JT-65 and the like are examples. RTTY and PSK are also long standing, successful narrow band modes that meet the needs of the amateur community. The ARRL has not clearly framed a need for this rule making. It might be that their true intention [allowing Pactor 4?] is not only not stated but against the interests of the current users of the spectrum.
