Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 18, 2011, the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) released the *USF/ICC Transformation Order*, which comprehensively reformed and modernized the universal service and intercarrier compensation systems.¹ In the *USF/ICC Transformation Order*, the Commission adopted a framework for providing ongoing support to areas served by price cap carriers, known as Connect America Phase II. The Commission delegated to the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) the task of implementing various aspects of Connect America Phase II.²

With this letter, the Bureau formally submits into the record the minor updates to the default inputs for the Connect America Cost Model (CAM) version 4.1.1 (v4.1.1).³ CAM v4.1.1 incorporates minor corrections to the broadband coverage used by the model, specifically, correcting the broadband coverage for approximately 5400 census blocks to reflect that these census blocks are not served by a fixed wireless provider. CAM v4.1.1 also contains updates to the TelcoMaster table to incorporate corrections to certain holding company names. The default inputs collection for CAM v4.1.1, which incorporates an update to one table (OCNCoSize) from the input collection for CAM v4.1, is publicly available via a link at:
