As a consultant in the field of Telecommunications and Microwave, I strongly agree with the opening of the 10GHz band to be used either under the unlicensed pt. 15 or "light" licensed (similar to the 3.65GHz spectrum) for general point-to-point high power use. This would relieve existing congestion in the 5GHz band, give a lower cost alternative to the use of the licensed 6 and 11GHz bands, and promote innovation, competition and the development of new technologies and products for extending the broadband infrastructure through the US, especially in rural areas.

I know from first-hand experience how congested the 5GHz ISM and UNII bands are becoming; allowing use of 10GHz would relieve this quickly and efficiently. I see no reason why this band can not be successfully shared between the current users and the broader wireless broadband community.

I already know of a number of local municipalities and school districts which would immediately benefit from such a rule making.
