
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 21, 2014, Dennis Henderson (CEO of Boomerang Wireless, LLC), Kim Lehrman (President of Boomerang Wireless, LLC) and Bill Courter of Courter Law, PLLC, participated in a conference call with Radhika Karmarkar, Deputy Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau, Telecommunications Access Division, and Michelle Schaefer, attorney-advisor, Wireline Competition Bureau, Telecommunications Access Division to discuss several issues related to the Lifeline program.

During the call, Boomerang officials expressed support for retention of proof documentation, which would also provide a factual basis in the event of any future audit by the Commission or by the Universal Service Administrative Company. Boomerang officials expressed support for *in-person* Lifeline events as one option for distribution. Specifically, Boomerang encouraged the FCC to reject the May 2013 Petition filed by TracFone requesting the FCC to prohibit such *in-person* distribution events. Finally, Boomerang officials discussed its pending (since December 2010) federal application for ETC designation in the federal jurisdiction states and requested FCC action upon such application.
