

I am writing to voice two concerns.

First, to urge the Commission to reject the concept of "Internet Fast Lanes" (AKA "Tiered Service"), which will tilt the playing field away from users and towards the interests of multinational corporations. The Internet needs to be classified as a telecommunications service and subject to common carrier regulation. If the Internet is today's printing press, it needs to be equally available to all Americans, or we have no free press.

Second, I request that industry spokesman Tom Wheeler be immediately removed from his position as FCC Chairman. His conflicts of interest should have disqualified him in the first place, and his actions indicate that he acts only in the interests of the industries the Commission is intended to regulate.

The Internet is the success that it is because access to it has been equally available to everyone from the biggest companies to tiny startups. The proposed "Fast Lane" concept makes the Internet into Just Another Cable Service, which is dangerous and foolhardy.
