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Wheeler is Obama's man. The President needs to step forward and clarify his own position. Anyone who believes that tiered pricing of the Internet will not lead to ISP control of content in the long run is delusional. Phrases like "commercially reasonable" as used by Wheeler in his discussion of newly proposed Open Internet rules are legally meaningless and unenforceable in this setting. The fact is that tiered pricing of Internet access controlled by the ISP's spells the end of Net Neutrality by any definition of the term. Wheeler and the President are deceptive if they do not acknowledge this basic fact. Furthermore, the entire regulatory issue created by the Federal Appeals Court ruling in January 2014 would disappear if the FCC had the guts to label the Internet accurately as a telecommunications medium. Apparently the White House does not have the stomach for the fight that would ensue by repairing the damage deliberately done by Michael Powell under GW Bush when they categorized the Internet merely as a digital information service. We need an honest and courageous FCC Chairman to stand up for the people and not for the corporations that want to dominate the Internet- which is a public utility created with tax payer money.
