After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2013 Funding Commitment Decision Letter for the Application Number indicated above. to each service provider that will provide the services approved for discounts in this letter. USAC will issue the RFCDL to you as soon as possible. The RFCDL will inform you of the precise dollar value of your approved funding request(s). As you await the RFCDL, you may share this Administrator's Decision on Appeal with the relevant service provider(s).

If the original FCDL approved funding in part for the services covered by this appeal, the 120 day deadline for filing FCC Forms 486 is determined based on the date of the original FCDL that approved funding for the request(s). However, if the original FCDL denied funding for the services covered by this appeal, FCC Forms 486 cannot be filed until you have received your RFCDL.

Since your appeal was denied in full, dismissed or cancelled, you may file an appeal with the FCC. Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 days of the date on this letter. Failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of your appeal. You should refer to CC Docket No. 02-6 on the first page of your appeal to the FCC.
