Concerning: Out of Window Waiver Request

I am requesting that an out of window waiver be granted for Menifee County School District, Entity Number 128774, USAC 471 Application Number 993648.

As Assistant Superintendent for Menifee County School District, I have filed all the USAC Applications for our school district for all 17 years (this year) that the E-Rate program has existed. I am very careful with filing each year. Triple and Quadruple checking everything so as not to leave out anything or make a mistake. I always make a handwritten list every year of absolutely everything that I need to file on our 470 Application. I filed our 470 Application 330780001205780 this year on 01/23/2014 making sure that everything needed was listed on it under Block 2, Line 8, Telecommunications and/or Internet Access, and Line 11, Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections. We did not list anything under Line 10, Internal Connections Other Than Basic Maintenance, this year. When the 28 days was past, and we were past the Allowable Contract Date of 02/20/2014, I started working on the 471 Application. It was then that I discovered that Web Hosting was not listed under Telecommunications and/or Internet Access. It should have been. I am confident that I put it on there, but yet it was not there. That was very distressing. Something like that had never happened in all of my years of filing. I called the USAC helpline (1-888-203-8100) and was advised (as I already knew) that it was not a correctable error and could not be added to that 470 application. However they said I could file another 470 application, even though late, and then file a 471 after the allowable contract date, even though out of window, and then ask the FCC for an out of window waiver to allow it to count in the window, if approved by the FCC. I am asking for the out of window waiver with this request.

I do not believe that I left Web hosting off the first 470 application. I tend to believe that either somehow it did not get saved onto the form when I typed it in and I did not catch it before I submitted it (thinking that it was on there). With my habit of triple and quadruple checking I cannot see how that happened, so secondly I don't know if it is possible that somehow it got deleted later or not (maybe). There is always the possibility that I somehow left it off (but I do not think so).

You can review the 470 and 471 applications as well as the 471 FCDL's and see that starting with Funding Year 2011 we have been filing for Web Hosting. So there is just no reason why I would have left it off our first 470 Application for Funding Year 2014.

The amount is not major. \$3,800 is the allowable amount I filed for as you can see on the 471 Application cited above. 87% is our district shared discount rate.

Considering all the above and the other past 471 Application evidence, I most humbly ask that you please grant the out of window waiver requested above.
